

Worksheet 6. *Examine some impersonal action inflections.*

Impersonal actions inflect the bare action, independent of a subject.

Impersonals *only* inflect tense and agency, but *not* the person.


Impersonals end in *-ειν* or *-αι*, and retain reduplication, but *drop augment*.

Impersonals appear *only* in the present, future, aorist, and perfect tenses.

From λύω *I loose*: λελυκέ^{ναι} *have loosed*.

Perfect active impersonal.


λε·λυ·χ·έ·ναι.



From λείπω *I leave*: λιπέσθαι *had left*.

Second aorist, intensive impersonal.


λιπ·έ·σθαι.



From πληρώω *I fill*: πληρώσειν *will fill*.

Future, active impersonal.

πληρ·ώ·σ·ει·ν.
